

9:30 am be ready to line up past the Ballroom.



When: The Parade starts at 10 am and will take about 30-45 minutes to complete the route (1/2 mile). See [page two](#) for more information and the parade route.

Parking: Following the signs to the Ballroom around the back. There is a lot of space to park for the parade participants.

Bring: Music and lyre. You may want to wear sunscreen and a hat to protect you from the sun.

Cases: Leave them in your car.

Wear: Patriotic colors or blue band shirts and black or navy-blue shorts or pants depending on the weather. Good walking shoes.

DIRECTIONS:

From Hwy I-270 going south: Take Exit #3-Hwy 30/Gravois Rd. As you approach the intersection, stay in the 2nd lane from the right marked HWY 30 West-Gravois Road. (Do not get in the far-right lane.) At the stoplight, turn right and immediately move over to the 2 left hand turn lanes. Turn left on Kennerly Road. Turn Right at the T to Gravois Road.

Go to the entrance just past the Delta Dental building on the right - Turn right on Pointe Dr. Turn right at the next stop sign and right again at the following stop sign. (Do **not go to the Main Entrance/Clubhouse). Follow Village Circle Drive to the right to The Crossing (12503) BUT turn right at the sign going past the Ballroom around the back of the building. There are many parking spots that are not reserved where you may park. The parade starts at the top of the hill.

From I-270 going North.: Take Exit #3-Hwy 30/Gravois Rd. At the stoplight turn left on Hwy 30 West over the highway and immediately move over to the 2 left hand turn lanes. Turn left on Kennerly Road. Turn right at the "T" to Gravois Road. Follow the rest of the directions above. **

From South Lindbergh Blvd: Go west on Gravois/Hwy 30 over I-270. Immediately get into 2 left hand turn lanes. Turn left on Kennerly Road and right on Gravois Rd. Follow the directions above. **
